GENERAL SERVICE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011**

AVAILABILITY

Available to members of the REMC for all non-residential purposes, seasonal and farm operations (maximum demand of less than 10 kW) and whose maximum load requirements do not exceed 50 KVA transformer capacities. Customers whose 12-month average demand exceeds 10 kW will automatically be transferred to the appropriate rate.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Alternating current, 60-hertz, single-phase, 120/240 volts; or three-phase*, 240 volts or other standard voltage values mutually agreeable to the member and the REMC. Standby or resale service is not permitted under this rate schedule.
