In July 2003, WWVREMC started the Operation Round Up program. With your generous support, we have given back over \$644,000 to the communities we serve, work and live in. We are kicking off

our Operation Round Up membership drive this month to celebrate this milestone. The campaign is usually held during the fall, but we wanted to do something a little different for the 20th anniversary.

When I first heard of this program from another cooperative, I knew it was a program for this generous co-op family. When I presented the idea to the board, they were 100% behind the program. They appointed the first trustees, approved articles of incorporation, notified the membership, and we were underway.

Since then, 11 trustees have volunteered their service to the program, and more than 890 grants have been awarded throughout all six of our counties. Our participation rate starting out was high at 84% but has fallen to 36%. Can you help us get those numbers back up and sign up today? Rounding up averages \$6.00 annually and cannot

be more than \$11.88. Multiply that by our number of accounts and the impact is tremendous.

To Report an Outage or Emergency

Call 1-800-776-0493, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Login to your SmartHub account and report your outage.

Be ready to provide the following information:

- The name and account number under which your electric service is listed.
- Map location number.
- Your phone number needed to call back or confirm power restoration.
- The type of problem you are experiencing flickering lights, complete power outage, etc.



UNCLAIMED CAPITAL CREDITS

Do we owe you money?

Most refunds are returned to the cooperative because we do not have the former member's current mailing address or contact information. To see if you are on the list of unclaimed capital credits, go to our website at **wwvremc.com/unclaimed-capital-credits** and search by your name. If your name is on the list, complete the form and submit it to the WWVREMC office.
